DESCRIPT : **Establishes provisions relating to an automated victim information and notification system. Requires the department of public safety to establish a statewide automated victim information and notification system to automatically notify a registered victim or concerned member of the community of the status of the offender. Requires the prosecuting agency to notify the victim of their right to register and makes the victim responsible for registering. Requires the attorney general, the chiefs of police, and the prosecuting attorneys to cooperate in establishing and maintaining the system. Establishes the automated victim information and notification system special fund administered by the department to be used for the system, including specified limits and prohibitions. Establishes an automated victim information and notification system governance committee permitted to advise the department on specified issues. Provides limited civil and criminal liability for members of the committee acting in good faith and within the scope of their duties but not where the member acts with gross negligence, wilful and wanton misconduct, or intentional misconduct. -- Requires the department to continue to operate the statewide automated victim information and notification system pursuant to the funding structure under which it operated on June 30, 2012, which may include the use of federal funds, until such time as the automated victim information and notification system special fund has accumulated sufficient moneys to carry out the purposes of the act. -- Appropriation out of the special fund; provided that the funds shall be made available upon the accumulation of sufficient moneys in the automated victim information and notification system special fund to carry out the purposes of the act. DESCRIPT : **Prohibits physicians, osteopathic physicians, surgeons, or students participating in a course of instruction, residency program, or clinical training program from performing a pelvic examination on an anesthetized or unconscious female patient unless the patient gives prior verbal or written informed consent to the pelvic examination, the performance of a pelvic examination is within the scope of care for the surgical procedure or diagnostic examination scheduled to be performed on the patient, or the patient is unconscious and the pelvic examination is required for**
